This collection contains documents compiled by the **Communist Party of Great Britain's (CPGB) Women's Department** during the period 1944-1991. The records include minutes, agendas, and promotional materials from various women's campaigns, events, and conferences.

They also include copies of Link, the party's women's magazine, and *Red Rag*, a controversial journal published by the party's more militant feminist members.

Together, these items provide a unique insight into the relationship between Western communism and the women's liberation movement during the post-war era.

The collection is accompanied by 3 contextual essays written by **Professor Kevin Morgan**, a senior academic at the University of Manchester.
