Scottish Nationalist Leaflets, 1844-1973, curated in association with the **National Library of Scotland**, provides an unparalleled insight into the growth of Scottish nationalism from the mid-nineteenth to the late twentieth century.

The 1707 Acts of Union united the Scottish and English Parliaments to form the Parliament of Great Britain in the Palace of Westminster. Thenceforth Scottish citizens have debated the viability of an independent Scotland.

Documents in this collection contain a wealth of information on the subject of Scottish independence, including: pamphlets from the Scottish National Party; financial policy proposals; documents assessing the effect on international relations; and the revival of Scottish cultural independence.

This is an excellent resource for those interested in studying the history of Scottish nationalism and calls for Scottish independence, this is set to be a dominant political movement of the twenty-first century.
