
## **Explore communist perspectives through...**

This collection is part of the *British* Communism at Home and Abroad, 1883-1991 series.




The collection contains over 5,000 unique images.

Papers from the Jewish Committee chart the rise of fascism in Europe and demonstrate the CPGB's central place to the resistance of fascism at home and abroad.


The West Indies Committee and Race Relations Committee offer a fascinating look at immigration and integration in the post-war years.

Other featured documents provide a unique insight into communist perspectives on healthcare provision, parliamentarianism, and communist society across the Iron Curtain.


## ...specialised departmental and committee work
